



## **RULES of behaviour in case of emergency at the Apart-Hotel**

**Attention! All Apart-hotel areas, including apartments, are equipped with fire alarms and alerts in case of an emergency.**

In order to avoid smoke and fire alarms, you must use extractor fan in the kitchen area during cooking.

### **It is strictly forbidden:**

- To smoke on the territory of the Apart-hotel, including apartments and all public areas.
- Operate electric wires and cables with visible insulation defects.
- The use of open fire in the building and premises is prohibited.
- Leaving the apartment, do not leave unattended electrical appliances, including those in standby mode (TV, radio, air conditioner, lighting lamps, chargers, etc.).
- We remind you that it is dangerous to cover the switched on floor lamps and table lamps with items made of combustible material.
- It is unacceptable to bring and store explosive, fire-explosive and fire-hazardous substances and materials in apartments.
- Do not leave small children unattended and do not allow children to play with matches and lighters.
- If you arrive in the apart-hotel for the first time, try to remember the location of emergency exits and stairs.

### **If there is fire in your apartment:**

- Immediately report **the incident to the fire brigade by phone 01 or 112** (mobile communication), indicating the address of the object, the floor and your name; to **the dispatcher on duty of the complex at 8931-360-95-56** or to the receptionists at the internal **phone number "0101" or city phone number (812) 333-42-02.**
- Don't panic!
- Take all possible measures to eliminate the fire-using fire extinguishing equipment;
- If it is not possible to eliminate the fire source on your own, leave the apartment and close the door without locking it;
- Be sure to inform the duty personnel about the fire;
- Leave dangerous zone and operate under the instructions of administration.

### **If there is fire out of your apartment:**

- Immediately report the incident to the fire brigade by phone - **01 or 112 (mobile communication), the duty dispatcher of the complex at 8931-360-95-56 or the reception staff at the internal phone number "0101" or city phone number 8 (812) 333-42-02;**
- Leave your apartment after closing the windows and doors; if the corridors and stairwells are heavily smoked and you cannot leave the apartment, stay in your room with the windows wide open.
- A closed and well-sealed door can strongly protect you from dangerous temperatures. To avoid smoke poisoning, close the slots and vents holes with water-soaked towels or bedding;
- When the firefighters arrive at the scene of the incident, go to the window and give a sign about helping you.
